He was pleasantly surprised at just how quick the recovery proved to be. After receiving a general anaesthetic, he underwent micro-incision cataract surgery with implantation of a multifocal lens. By the time he arrived home that same day, he removed the protective cover from his eye and had near perfect vision. After the operation on the second eye, his vision was the best it had been for years and he felt well enough to take a flight to Spain the next day, and even drove at the other end. "My eyesight really was that good," he remarks.


